Please continue to support our school uniform policy. If you require any support with this do not hesitate to contact the school. Our uniform consists of:

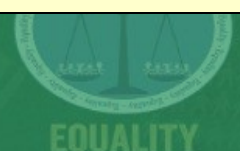
- Blazer (optional but encouraged)
