- Open Actions
  - School Estate Plan (CH/CD)
    - See tracker (emailed with agenda for tonight).
    - THS PC sent all councillors an email with list of concerns – felt public announcement focused on outcome that wasn't necessarily explored during internal meetings which members of PC had attended; our priority is to keep Trinity High at top of the priority list (Renfrew High were not in-line to receive a new school), not a joint campus. Council saying that King George V site is not the only option.
    - Action: CH/CD to ask Council for more clarity; thank councillors; put meeting with Council estates staff on hold for now; ask Diocese staff for a meeting; schedule a meeting to include clusters, Gerard and Jack once next paper has been seen; send PM a link to PC sway/Facebook to provide parents with update from PC to be included in the HT Blog.
- Head Teacher's Report
  - Events since we last met: Catholic Education Fortnight, various trips, Anti-Bullying Week, Remembrance Day, Visit from Trinity (Ireland), Halloween Disco, EKOSTem, Good News Visit, Show Racism the Red Card, Hot Choc and Talk (World Mental Health Day).

- Matters Arising

  - Bronze pupils will be supported to complete their awards; Silver group to be supported on expedition – staff need to update first aid/we can pay reps to take expedition – still to be decided; group nearly completed Silver so school will co-ordinate to get these pupils through by assigning to Mr McEwan, he is currently working on this; school needs to get a co-ordinator in place. No new DofE groups will run this year during the transition period.
  - PM will ask Mr McEwan to provide outline via letter and share with all DofE pupils.
