Dear Parents, Carers and Pupils of S6,

The date has almost arrived, and we are really looking forward to hosting our final senior event for the young people of S6. Our Prom committee has worked tirelessly to make this year's event a success and the 2026 Prom will take place at the Glasgow Marriot Hotel, on Friday 12th June at 7.00pm.

Following from the successful experience of previous years, we have organised a pre- Prom reception on school grounds. Pupils should arrive no earlier than 5.45 pm with the bus leaving at approximately 6.30 pm to go to the hotel.

On arrival, there will be a Red-Carpet welcome and mocktail provided by the hotel. A DJ has been provided as part of the Prom package and music will continue until 10.45pm, with the Prom finishing at 11pm. Hotel staff, along with teaching staff, will be supervising entry to the venue to ensure that young people can celebrate and enjoy themselves in a safe and secure environment. Any young person intending to purchase alcohol at this event must be over the age of 18, with identification required to prove this is the case. 'Proof of age' identification checks will be carried out by hotel staff and wristbands issued to those eligible to purchase alcohol.

We would like to make clear to students that, if we have any concerns regarding their welfare, parents and carers will be contacted immediately and asked to collect their son/daughter from the venue. This will apply to any young person who is caught in possession of alcohol whilst entering the school or hotel premises.

We expect this to be a very successful and enjoyable evening which will mark the many wonderful years at Trinity High School.
