Modern Languages for Life and Work Award at Level 3

The level 3 award focuses on practical language skills for real-life, social and workplace situations. Learners use French or Italian to communicate basic information, interact with others and understand simple texts relevant to everyday life and employment. Emphasis is on confidence, employability, and transferable communication skills. The course is internally assessed. The Building Employability Skills can be done as a stand-alone unit and is completed in English

Modern Languages for Life and Work at Level 6 will develop knowledge and skills in areas such as society, culture and employability. This course focuses on practical language skills for real-life, social and workplace situations. Pupils who study a Higher language have the opportunity to achieve these units alongside the Higher.
