

Williamsburgh Primary School Covid guidance Issued: August 2020



We are following Scottish Government and Renfrewshire guidance in making these decisions. These are constantly under review and we will update and publish this document whenever guidance changes.

What we are doing to keep your children safe

Cleaning

- Cleaning tables regularly during the school day.
- Cleaning classrooms every day.
- Cleaning touch points throughout the day. (Door handles, banisters etc)

Lunches

- Lunch boxes kept in children's bags, where possible
- Dinner hall tables cleaned before and after a child eats.
- During wet play and lunchtimes children need to stay in their own seat and classroom.

Breaks and Lunchtimes

- Break and lunchtimes are split so that there are fewer children outside.
- Playground has been divided into zones to provide plenty of space.
- Children are encouraged to play with children from their own class.

Corridors

• Children will walk through the corridors in a single file to allow space for other classes and adults to pass.

Outdoor PE

- All PE will take place outdoors, please wear suitable clothing.
- Cleaning PE equipment before and after use.

Outdoor Education and Daily Mile

- We will be taking children outdoors regularly to experience a variety of lessons across the curriculum.
- Most days children will go outside for the Daily Mile.

Classrooms

- Desks will be in rows and face the front. (P3-7)
- Pupils will be given verbal feedback and support.
- Library books will be kept in trays.
- Water bottles can be filled up and used during the day.
- Coats will be hung up on an allocated peg.
- Bags will be kept under desks.
- Children are asked to stay in their seat and put their hand up when they need help.
- Classroom doors and windows will be kept open all day. Please bring a jumper.

Handwashing

- Hand sanitiser is available at different places throughout the school.
- Children sanitise or wash their hands
 - when they arrive,
 - before and after break,
 - before and after lunch,
 - before going home.

What we are not doing at the moment

- Changing for PE.
- Singing.
- Sharing resources with other classes.
- Moving around the classroom.
- Having parents in the building.
- Having large gatherings of staff or pupils. (Assemblies, Staff meetings, etc)
- Playing on the trim trail and exercise equipment.
- Homework jotters will not be sent home.
- No buddies or monitors.
