- Navy Trousers/Skirt/Pinafore/Shorts
- Navy/White Tartan Skirt/Pinafore
- Blue/White Check Summer Dress
- White Shirt/Polo Shirt (with or without badge)
- Navy Jumper/Cardigan/Sweatshirt (with or without badge)
- Navy Blazer
- Navy Tie/Silver Stripes
- Dark Shoes

We are committed to promoting health, wellbeing and active lifestyles with our pupils. At Woodlands PS all pupils participate in 2 hours of quality P.E. each week.

At the start of the year, you will be notified of your child's P.E. days. On these days they should bring a change of clothes and shoes – this is essential for the safety and hygiene of our pupils.

Our P.E. Kit consists of

- White T-shirt or polo shirt (badged or unbadged)
- Navy/Black shorts
- Sports shoes/trainers – these must fasten securely and not be worn outside



Please keep jewellery and valuables at home – if your child is wearing earrings, they must cover these up with tape prior to participating or remove them.

In Primary 7, we recognise our senior students with a slight adaption to the uniform policy

Our senior pupils have the option to wear the senior tie – this was designed by one of our pupils and selected through a voting process. Every pupil will be gifted a senior tie at the end of Primary 6 as they prepare for their final year here at Woodlands PS.



Hoodies are a privilege reserved for our P7 pupils and should not be worn at other stages. The Leavers Hoodies will be organised by the school for P7 pupils in Term 4 of each school year. These can be worn in addition to other uniform items.
