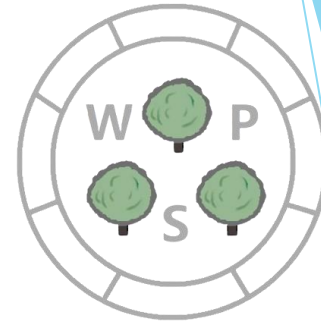

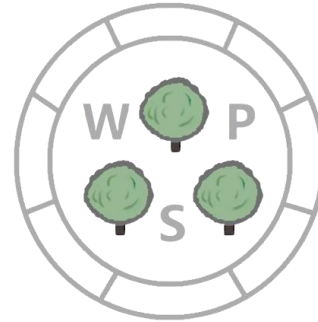
- ▶ P1 Class

- ▶ Label EVERYTHING!!!

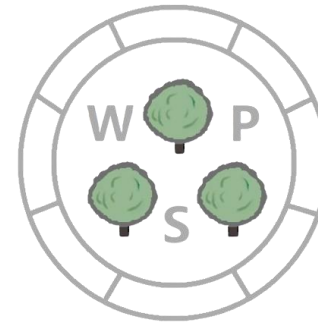

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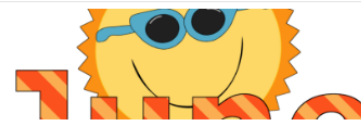

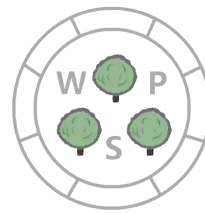

- ▶ Don't be afraid to raise your concerns with the school - we will always work together to a resolution



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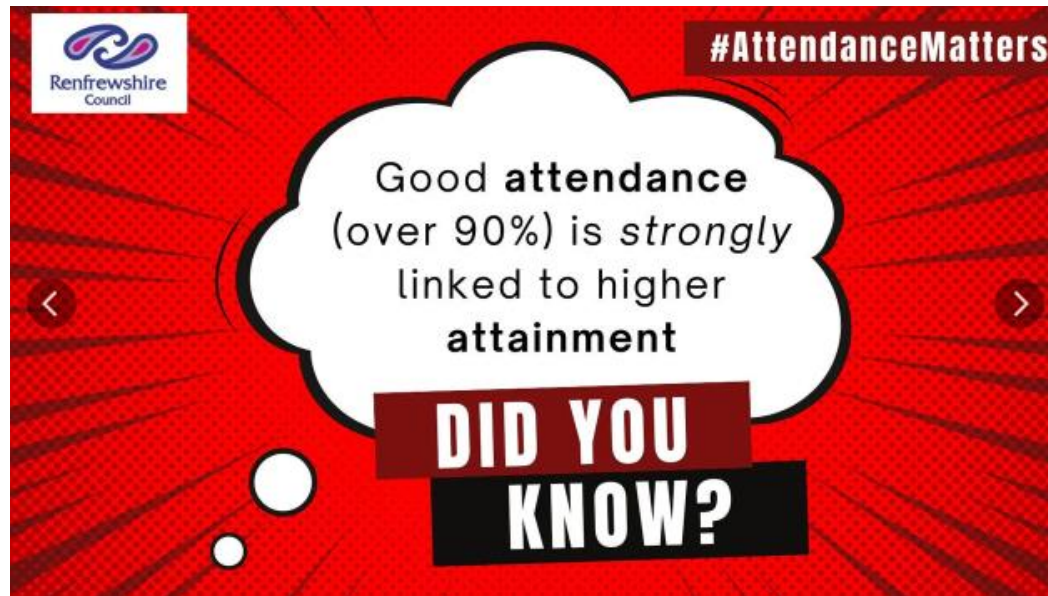
Beginning of Term

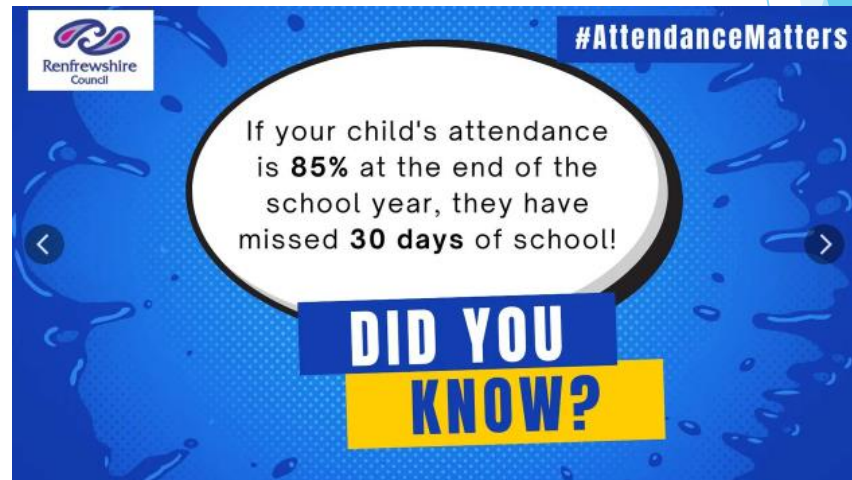

DID YOU KNOW?


#AttendanceMatters

Children with **less than 80%** attendance are between 5 and 7 times more likely **not** to reach the expected levels in key subjects by S3
