Spotlight: Attendance Matters

Our school attaches great importance to attendance and we are committed to working in partnership with parents/carers to maximise pupil attendance and ensure the best outcomes for our young people.

Research shows that good attendance and timekeeping can have a significant impact on education but also post school positive destinations.

Good attendance is important for developing your child's skills for life. There are lots of supports we can offer to help you or your child if you are worried about attendance or facing any challenges with getting your child to school.

95%	=	40 LESSONS MISSED EACH YEAR 8 days in total or 1 week and 3 days
90%	=	80 LESSONS MISSED EACH YEAR 16 days in total or 3 weeks and 1 day
85%	=	120 LESSONS MISSED EACH YEAR 24 days in total or 4 weeks and 4 days
80%	=	160 LESSONS MISSED EACH YEAR 32 days in total or 6 weeks and 2 days
