Term 3 - What we will be learning

The children will continue to support and build trusting relationships with adults and children, becoming aware of and expressing feelings and developing their ability to talk about them. Children will have opportunities to manage their own risk, participate in different kinds of energetic play both indoors and out, improve their own learning through trial and error and encourage learning and confidence in others.

The children will be exploring money through role play, developing an understanding of how money is used, value and early addition and subtraction. Opportunities to consider sharing equally, splitting whole objects into smaller parts and discovering fractions within their play. Recognising patterns within their natural environment involving objects, shape, number and colour.

Children will have ample opportunity to discover, ask questions, be curious and link what they are learning to what they already know. Using their imaginations to invent their own stories/characters and share their thoughts in many ways, discovering new language and documenting their ideas through mark making.

The children will be handling, tasting, talking and learning about different foods, discovering where foods come from and how they are prepared differently. Learning about similarities and differences in friends and respecting other opinions, exploring the rights to which they and others are entitled.
