


St James' Primary School Parent /Carer Questionnaire March 2017

Responses to areas for development :-

- ➤ This year we have seen a rise in the amount of extra-curricular clubs available. They run every morning, lunch time and after school. Details of these clubs are issued by letter at the start of each term. - ➤ This year we have introduced a Health and Wellbeing programme called 'Bounce Back' that promotes resilience. Various coping strategies including mindfulness are currently being used. Yoga has also been incorporated into class PE lessons. A parent information session will be held in the near future
