## Numeracy

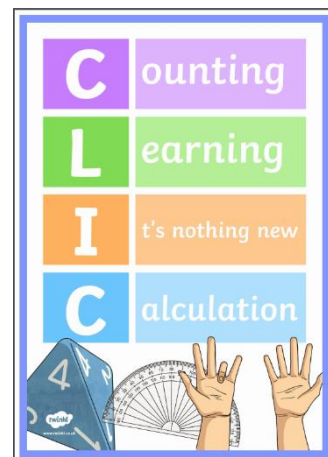
On a Monday we will practise the skills we learn in our weekly CLIC. The word CLIC is an acronym which means each letter stands for a word,
