Parent Council Accounts

You helped us raise £4529.40 last year. Our expenditure included expenses for the Jubilee picnic, EYC and infant department gifts, P7 leavers ties and class photos, Christmas party treats, garden supplies for the EYC and Christmas raffle expenses totalling £2797.11.

£900 has been committed to cover half of the pantomime bus fare, leaving £2253.46 in the account at the start of term 1.
