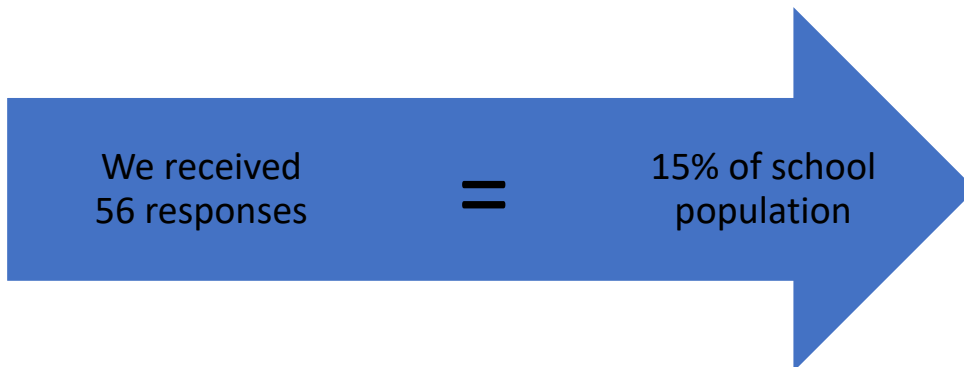


Alloway Primary School – Parental Survey February 2023
