Tempest Photography

Back in March we sent out a survey to parents regarding Tempest. We had 95 responses and we organised a meeting with Tempest to discuss the findings. In short, the benefits of remaining with Tempest outweigh looking for an alternative photographer.


Reasons being, Tempest provide 25% commission to the school on every product sold. Their photographers are all PVG checked and photos taken are held securely. They provide school photos of every child free of charge to the school to be kept on every pupil's file and this is updated every 2 years. They also keep photos of children for 10 years so replacements can be offered. The only problem being, Tempest is UK wide and has a marketing department that deliver the choice of products but feedback such as ours can add weight to new products being brought out. New products will already be available to buy this school year with more photos including siblings.

Unfortunately, prices cannot be changed locally as they are agreed at a national level. by Tempest.
