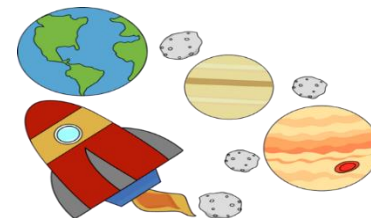

Primary 6 Learning Journey Term 1



Mathematics

We are consolidating our knowledge on number and the four operations. We will learn about estimating and rounding numbers up to 1,000,000, with a focus on place value. An exciting new development for the children will be deepening their understanding of decimals, working with tenths and hundredths. In addition, we will extend our understanding of numbers below zero. In number talks and our daily CLIC sessions we are continuing to develop our mental strategies across the four operations, focussing on speed and accuracy. We will be developing our understanding of 2D shapes and 3D objects. We will identify their properties and learn how to make 2D nets.

Science

We are very excited about commencing our scientific journey into space! We will learn all about the planets, moons, asteroids, comets and meteoroids that make up the solar system we live in. We will regularly check the news for exciting space updates as part of our listening and talking. We will also explore life onboard the International Space Station.

Literacy

This term we will be reading Kensuke's Kingdom by Michael Morpurgo. We will gain a rich understanding of the text through Making Thinking Visible routines, drama, writing in role and guided close reading. We will learn progressive spelling patterns and apply them in our writing. Our fictional writing focus will be imaginative writing linked to our space topic and Kensuke's Kingdom and our non-fictional writing will focus on the features of information reports.

Health and Well being

Our HWB will extend to an interdisciplinary approach this term with our brand new topic, common to every classroom in the school, of Fresh Start. This will encompass a focus on our rights and responsibilities through our class charter, discussing key features of modern life in Scotland such as democracy, religions within our country, dealing with discrimination and setting personal goals and targets.

In addition, we will enjoy twice weekly PE sessions (6W PE days are Wednesday and Friday and 6H on Wednesday and Thursday. We will be focussing on ball skills this first term, gaining experience in football and basketball

Expressive Arts

We will be exploring various art media throughout our space topic and our novel study. In music we will be learning an awareness of musical notation and pitch through playing the ukulele.

ICT

This term we will be using ICT to research and present our knowledge and understanding of space and the solar system. Children will go on to film their presentations on the moon and earth using ipads. We will consolidate saving and retrieving files as well as working on uplevelling the presentation features of our work.
