Alphablocks have another video to help us learn about the different ways to make this sound.

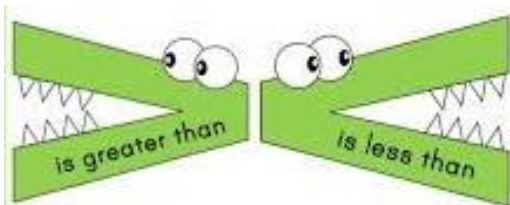

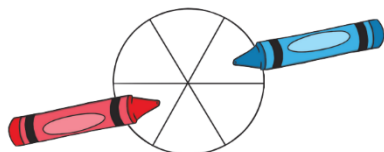
Other- Expressive Arts
