

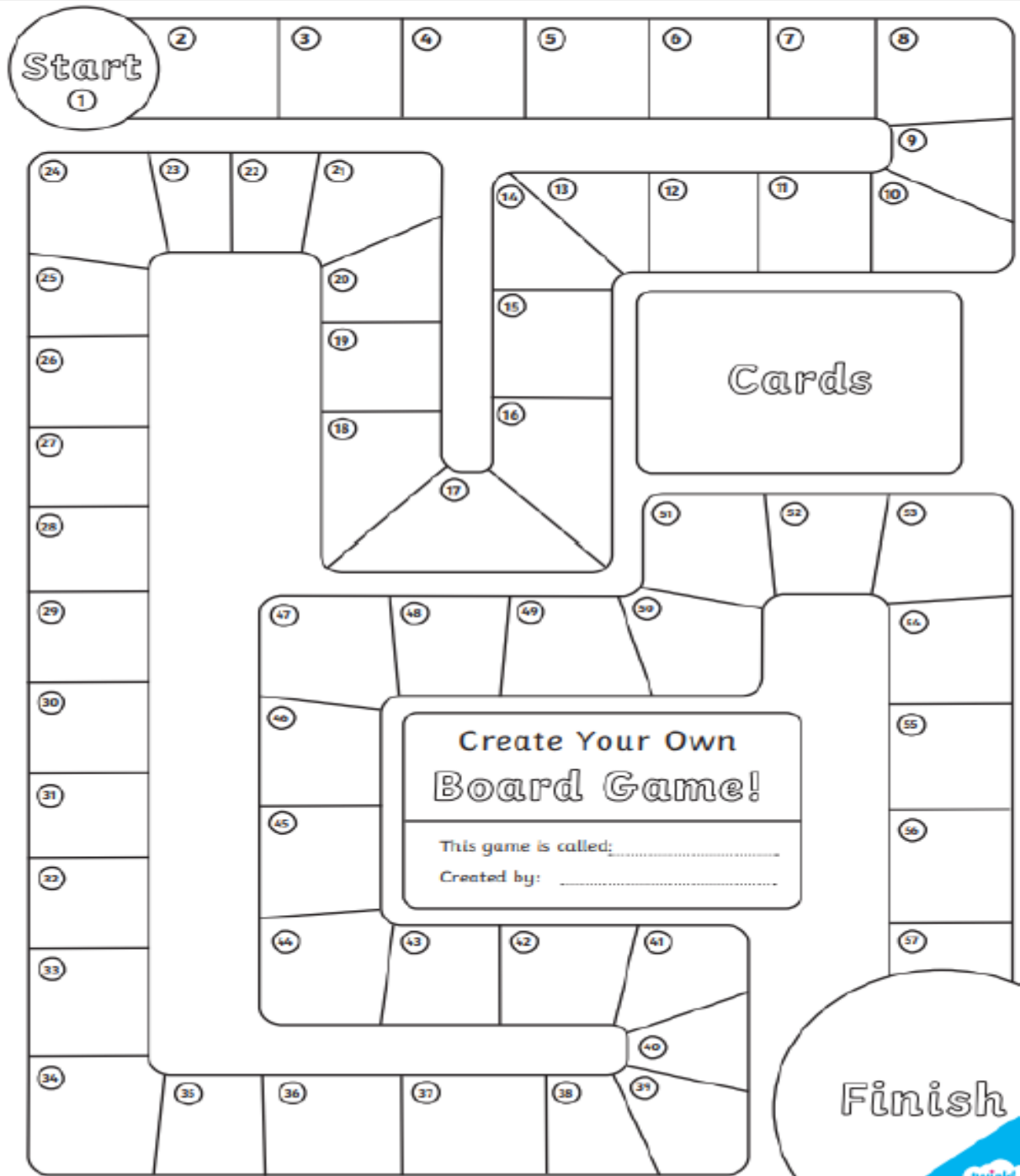
I: To create a board game using my addition and subtraction skills to get from start to finish
