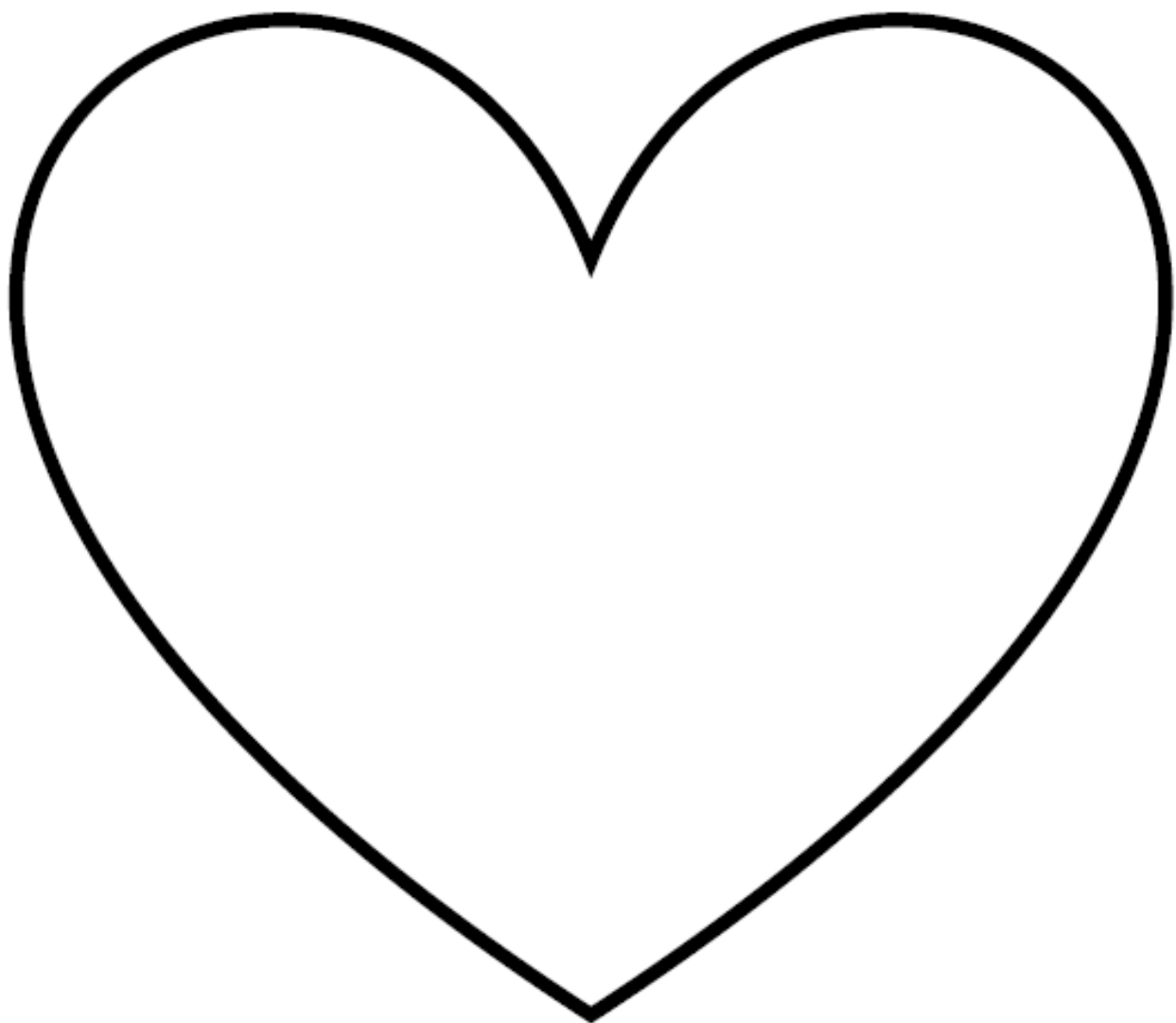

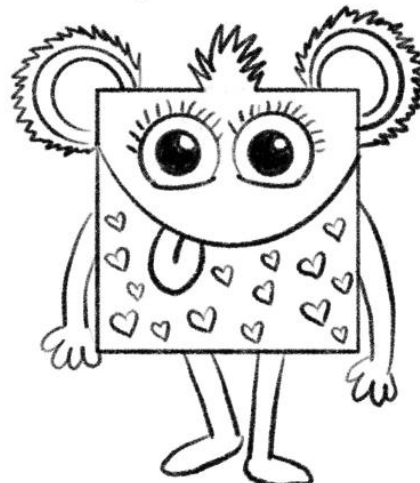
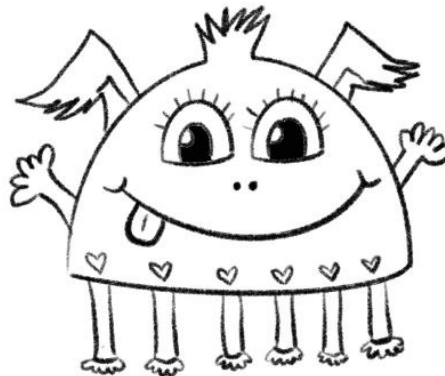
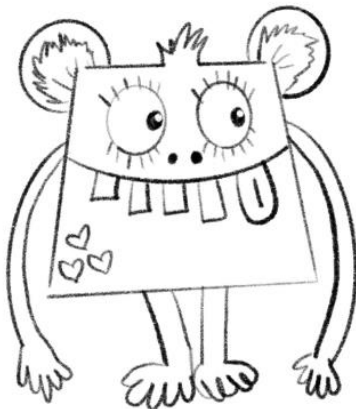
THEIR KIND ACTS:
