**Literacy**

L.I. To practise our spelling and vocabulary skills

- \*I can focus on spelling patterns practised in school
- \*I can show vocabulary awareness through incorporating words into sentences
- \*I can edit and uplevel my sentences to produce high-quality, well-punctuated sentences.

Our task today is creating sentences from a spelling and vocabulary sheet. You will need a dice or an online dice.

First, roll the dice

Next, choose a word from the row that matches the dice roll.

Use the word to create a sentence – get an idea in your head and then stop and apply your VCOP skills.

What's VCOP?

- \*V = vocabulary. Use the very best words you can.
- \*C = connective. Try to form complex sentences using interesting connectives. Look at the grid below for ideas.
- \*P=punctuation. Challenge yourself to use interesting punctuation in your sentences (see grid)
- \*O= opener. Think of the interesting ways we can open sentences. Again, refer to the grid below.
