Children on Staged Intervention

Where additional support needs are identified, children in our EYC are supported with Staged Intervention paperwork which identifies specific targets for children to work on. Paperwork will be shared with parents in September and February with targets being evaluated in June. Some children will also have either annual reviews or Team Around the Family meetings. The Staged Intervention process is being reviewed by South Ayrshire Council so we will be in touch regarding any changes to our policy. Mrs Gilmour will be working alongside keyworkers to set September targets soon, and will be sharing these with parents.
