

Primary 2 Learning Journey Term 3

Interdisciplinary Topic

This term we will be learning about Scotland over a 2 week block followed by our topic on Scottish Islands. This will allow us to explore a variety of experiences and outcomes within social subjects.

Within our Scotland topic we will learn a Scots poem which we will perform as a class to the rest of the school. We will also be learning about the life of John Loggie Baird and why he was famous. We will be investigating our local area using mapping skills to find areas of interest around Alloway.

For our Scottish Islands topic, we will be looking at fiction and non-fiction texts to create imaginative poems, stories and fact files about the similarities and differences of the Scottish mainland and Scottish islands. We will be writing to a primary school on Isle of Arran and taking part in a video call Q and A with an Arran resident to gain a better understanding of island life. We will also use digital resources to investigate the landscapes of Scottish islands and how these differ from our local area.

Health and Wellbeing

Numeracy and Mathematics

This term our focus is on multiplication and division. We will be exploring a range of strategies including doubles, repeated addition, equal groups and arrays.

Children will recognise division as sharing and grouping. Children will work with a variety of concrete materials to support them with these concepts. They will explore the link between multiplication and division and then progress onto fractions. In maths, our focus will be on journeys and directions, grid references and measure.

We will continue to apply our learning through real life problem solving and CLIC sessions.

This term we will be learning about Day and Night. We will be focusing on the sun and the moon and how these affect the seasons, days and hours.

Literacy

This term in writing, we will be focusing on poetry and functional writing. Children will continue to focus on their writing targets throughout; ensuring that they use capital letters, full stops, finger spaces and neat handwriting.

We will be beginning our block of talk4writing this term where our focus will be on describing a setting. The children will develop their skills in an active approach which will take them through the three stages - imitation, innovation and independent application.

In reading, we will continue to develop our fluency and expression as well as our phonics recognition and reading comprehension.

Our listening and talking skills will be developed through our topic work. Children will be given the opportunity to perform their Scots poem in front of their peers.
