In Terms 1-4 staff complete a SHANARRI wheel with children to allow them to reflect about the Wellbeing Indicators and gauge how they feel about their wellbeing and their learning. This feeds into our Staged Intervention paperwork and Team Around the Family meetings. Children are supported in class and out with class and are given opportunities to express their views about this. Staff act upon children's views.






A powerpoint was used to explore the themes with children. Video links were used to further explain.




Back in class, teachers used a Padlet to gather children's views after a class discussion



Primary 4-7 children completed a pupil survey to further gather children's views about their learning.



Staff tool all the HGIOURS and Pupil survey information and interrogated this during our February In-service. Staff evaluated what children saw as school strengths and areas for improvement. This was collected together in a Padlet.



- This interrogated information will now form a You Said We Did display which we will share with children during assemblies. It is important for children to see how we are valuing their voice and what we are doing about it.
- The results of this interrogation will form part of our Year 2 School Improvement Plan. We will take directly from children's views and feed this into our improvement plan.
