



Mathematics

This term we will enjoy beginning algebraic equations and start to explore the rules of BODMAS. In addition we will be delving into measure and applying our skills to solve practical problems involving distance, weight, volume and capacity. Data handling will be our final large topic, where we will gain experience in interrogating and displaying data in a range of formats.
