Primary 7 Learning Journey Term 2

Literacy

Article 30

Writing

This term we are aiming to develop our imaginative writing skills. Our targets include:

Creating a convincing scene, events, atmosphere and characters

Story organisation
Entertaining the reader
Accurate use of paragraphs
Variation of sentence types
Effective conclusions
Accurate spelling and punctuation



Reading

We will be linking our reading with our World War II topic and will study the book Goodnight Mr Tom. We will use this text to help increase critical analysis by encouraging pupils to use quotes to back up points and to give their opinion and thoughts about plot, character and setting. We will also develop skills in answering complex questions on a text.

Listening and Talking

We will be watching clips and newsreels from WW2 to encourage discussion about events and the effect they had on Scotland. Pupils will also have opportunities to speak at our virtual Remembrance Service. We are also encouraging them to ask at home about family members who fought in the war and to share these stories with the class.

ICT

Our Learning Journals are taking shape and pupils have been uploading examples of work and posting about their learning. They will continue to update these over the course of Term 2.

Internet safety and the use of social media will remain a priority for pupils.

Topic- World War II

We are studying World War 2 and will be learning about the effect it had on British citizens on the Home Front.

Pupils will be exploring the role of women in WWII as well as the impact the war had on children – many of whom were evacuees. Children will be creating a timeline of events from the war and will be using drama to enhance their learning.

The pupils will be offered to chance to research an aspect of WWII of their choice and to present this as a project.

Both P7 classes are currently working hard to prepare and lead our Remembrance Service on 11th November.

Mathematics and Numeracy



Topics we will work on this term include fractions, decimals and percentages and the mathematical link between these.

We will also study negative numbers, time and coordinates, scale, maps and plans. This will fit well with our topic and gives an opportunity for our pupils to apply their knowledge and understanding of these concepts.

Big Maths and Number Talks continue to be a daily part of class work and some homework tasks.

Article 29

Expressive Arts

Pupils will be learning songs from WWII as well as exploring propaganda posters and how they were used to boost morale. They will design their own propaganda posters. We will be using music as a stimulus for writing.

We are lucky to have Mrs Herbert leading us in music lessons. We will be learning and performing a selection of World War 2 songs.

Article 28

RME

We will be studying Ramadan. During this topic, we will be learning about the connection between customs of Ramadan and Muslim beliefs.

Afterwards, we will study how Christmas was celebrated in the past, for families and soldiers during WW2. P7 will then compare this to how our forces celebrate Christmas today when they are away from home.

Science

Pupils will be investigating forces through a range of scientific experiments. We will be focusing on air resistance and friction using the correct scientific terminology.

Health and Wellbeing

We will be exploring the journey of food from farm to fork. We will continue to set and work towards achieving our personal targets. **Please ask your child at home what their targets are.**
