Literacy

In Term 3 we will be reading the novel "The Wild Robot" by Peter Brown. We will be using the story to help us explore character and setting which will be the focus of our imaginative stories.

In listening and talking we will be learning how to perform a Scots poem and we will have the opportunity to participate in the poetry recital competition at the end of the month!

RME

We are learning about the Jewish and Islamic religious texts, the Torah and the Qur'an. We will be comparing these special religious texts to the Bible and will discuss how these books are important to religious people around the world.

Science


We are learning about the properties of different materials. This topic links to our class novel, "The Wild Robot".

Numeracy and mathematics

In numeracy we will develop our understanding of money by paying for items and calculating change in our shop. We will learn about coins and notes and will explore different methods of paying for goods digitally.

We will explore telling the time using both 12 and 24 hour notation.
