



TEAM WITH THE FAMILY MEETINGS

WHAT IS A TEAM WITH THE FAMILY MEETING?

A Team with the Family meeting is where the people involved in helping your child come together with you to create a plan of support.

WHO IS INVOLVED IN TEAM WITH THE FAMILY MEETINGS?

Your child's named person and others involved in their plan such as the school nurse or their social worker will usually attend.

SHOULD I ATTEND A TEAM WITH THE FAMILY MEETING?

You and your child are the most key part of the meeting, including to form the Child's Plan. Your child's voice must be at the heart of planning.

HOW CAN I BE INVOLVED AT A MEETING?

You should share thoughts, concerns, strengths or hopes for your child. You can highlight changes to be made if something isn't working.

WHAT IS A CHILD'S PLAN?

The Child's Plan is a document that clearly outlines the support your child will get. It includes the worries, the actions, who is responsible to support and check progress.

WHY IS THE PLAN IMPORTANT?

The Child's Plan helps everyone work together, including you, to ensure your child's needs are being met and they are getting the right support at the right time.
