Literacy

In Reading we will be focusing on comprehension skills through Land of Roar. We will also read a variety of stories linked to our Fresh Start topic. We continue to use strategies from South Ayrshire Reads to help us with our spelling and morphology.

In Writing, we will be creating portal stories with a focus on the setting. We will learn to use our senses to create engaging, immersive settings.

We will develop our listening and talking through our "Big Meetings" where we will discuss environmental issues that affect us. We will explore these issues by linking to our rights and the Global Goals.

Mrs Martin will be teaching us French on a weekly basis and in term 1 we will be sharing our feeling and opinions.

Technologies

We are learning how to independently create and save documents. We will be learning how to use search engines such as google to find information from the internet.



Numeracy and mathematics

In numeracy we will develop our understanding of whole number by looking at place value and consolidating our knowledge of the four operations.

We will be learning about 2D shapes and 3D objects. We are using our outdoor spaces to enhance our numeracy learning.



Science

We are learning about the five senses: touch, taste, sight, sound and smell. We will learn how our senses keep us safe and how people can be affected by sensory impairments. We will be learning how people can overcome barriers to learning and living with sensory impairments.

HWB, Social Studies and RME

This term we are very excited to be working on our whole school theme "A Fresh Start". We will be learning about our rights and how they impact our lives. We are learning about our school values and the importance of being kind, inclusive, safe and respectful. We will also be learning about democracy as we will be involved in voting for our new house captains!
