## Absence is authorised in the following circumstances:

- Illness
- Doctor or Hospital Appointments
- Meetings for Children's Hearings/Court/ Care Review
- Sport/Musical/ Drama Activities agreed by the school.
- Religious ceremonies/ Weddings/ Funerals of person(s) close to child.
- · Someone close to your child has died.
- Crisis/ serious difficulty at home of in the family.
- Gyspsy/ Traveller Family and school are made aware of travel & Return.
- Returning to country of origin for cultural reasons or to care for a relative.
- School transport is cancelled due to bad weather/ breakdown etc.

As long as you have informed Ayr Academy of a valid reason why your child is off this is recorded as an authorised absence. <u>However, these days off will still contribute to their overall attendance percentage.</u>

### **Unauthorised Absence**

South Ayrshire schools will not authorise absences in the following circumstances:

- Any unexplained absence unless you later provide a satisfactory explanation
- Most family holidays, unless there are exceptional circumstances
- Truancy, with or without your knowledge
