Primary 1 Registration

Our Pre-school early years children are now beginning to think about their future move to Primary 1. Registration of Primary 1 children will take place week beginning 15th January. If you wish to defer you child's entry to Primary 1 you are able to do this easily if your child's 5th birthday is after the end of July. Just let us know. If you are unsure what to do, please do not hesitate to contact me for a chat.

Early Year's Registration.

As yet, we do not have a definite date for 2-4-yearold registration for Early Years. This usually takes place sometime in February. We will be in touch with you as soon as this becomes available. Look out for these dates in social media etc.

Cosy Spaces

Cosy Space sessions have returned every Thursday afternoon from 2-3pm. The school hall is open to parents and members of the



community, everyone is invited to come along for a hot drink, a biscuit and some company. Each week a small number of children from the primary school attend the cosy space with a selection of board games and puzzles which visitors are welcome to join in with. Alternatively visitors can sit and have a chat with others. The children of Ballantrae primary school have loved spending time with visitors in their cosy space and hope that you will continue to join us on a Thursday afternoon.
