Learning Journals

PE Information

- Long hair should be tied back and all jewellery able to be removed independently by children. Staff cannot remove earrings for children.

Free School Meal and Clothing Grants

The Scottish Government have committed to providing a free school meal to all P1 to P5 pupils, however we are requesting that parents/carers who meet the eligibility criteria submit an application as this information will be used to pay free school meal payments during school holiday periods.

Children in P6 and P7 are charged 35p for milk.

Please note that applications need to be completed each school year and do not automatically continue.

You must apply each year.

Day to day communication with class teachers will take place through Learning Journals (more details to follow). In the meantime you can get messages to your child's teacher via the main office.
