P1 Registration for Session 2024/2025

Children whose 5 birthday is between 1 March 2024 and 28 February 2025 should be registered for education during the week commencing Monday 15 January 2024.

You should register your child online for either your catchment denominational or non-denominational primary school between Monday 15 January and Friday 19 January.

Children normally attend their catchment denominational or non-denominational school, however parents may make a placing request for their child to attend any other school under the management of the education authority. Parents/carers should be aware that they must register their child on-line for education at their catchment denominational or non-denominational primary school **and then** make an on-line placing request to a school of their choice. Placing requests for session beginning August 2024 should be completed online by 31 January 2024. Information relating to catchment areas and placing requests is available at

Free School Meal and Clothing Grants

Free School Meal/Clothing Grant applications for 2023/24 are available here -: <u>Educational grants - South Ayrshire</u> Council (south-ayrshire.gov.uk)

The Scottish Government have committed to providing a free school meal to all P1 to P5 pupils, however we are requesting that parents/carers who meet the eligibility criteria submit an application as this information will be used to pay free school meal payments during school holiday periods.

Please note that Clothing Grant eligibility criteria is now in line with the Criteria for Free School Meals. Information can be found using the link above.

If you need help with your application, you can call 0300 123 0900 to speak to a customer service advisor.

Children in P6 and P7 are charged 35p for milk.

Please note that applications need to be completed each school year and do not automatically continue.

You must apply each year.

Please inform the office of any changes to telephone numbers, home addresses or email addresses to ensure you can be contacted and to receive regular communication from us.


