Please note that Mrs Mills and myself do not receive messages through learning journals. Should you wish to make an appointment please contact the school office to do so.



Home Learning



We are changing the format of our class newsletters and home learning from P1-P7.

We have consulted previously on home learning and made changes to take into account feedback from both parents/carers and children. The number of children engaging in these planned learning activities is still very low and as a result we are adapting what we do from Monday 29th January 2024.

Children in P1-P3 will receive weekly phonics activities to engage with at home. This will include a decodable text or book for them to read to you at home. All phonemes (sounds) will have been taught by the class teacher. You will receive a newsletter each term with further information about what your child will be learning and where they can access activities if they would like to practise skills in other curricular areas.

In P4-P7 children will receive a termly class newsletter. This will outline what they will be learning in phonics, numeracy and maths and interdisciplinary learning. There will be information contained on what your child can do to continue their learning at home for each area.

Free School Meal and Clothing Grants

Free School Meal/Clothing Grant applications for 2023/24 are available here -: <u>Educational grants - South Ayrshire</u> Council (south-ayrshire.gov.uk)

The Scottish Government have committed to providing a free school meal to all P1 to P5 pupils, however we are requesting that parents/carers who meet the eligibility criteria submit an application as this information will be used to pay free school meal payments during school holiday periods.

Please note that Clothing Grant eligibility criteria is now in line with the Criteria for Free School Meals. Information can be found using the link above.

If you need help with your application, you can call 0300 123 0900 to speak to a customer service advisor.

Children in P6 and P7 are charged 35p for milk.

Please note that applications need to be completed each school year and do not automatically continue.

You must apply each year.
