Decodable word lists with the focus phoneme will be sent out weekly. Practise one or more of the following activities using the word list:

• Diacritically mark the words

- •Write each phoneme in a different colour
- •Find more words with the focus phoneme and add them to the word list

•Try to put the words into a sentence (can be a silly sentence)

•Write the words, focusing on formation and presentation

Reading

All reading books are decodeable and are aligned to our focus phoneme. Please encourage children to sound out and blend the words. Reading books should be <u>kept in</u> <u>children's bags at all times</u> for use in the classroom and will be changed on a weekly basis.

At Barassie we promote reading for pleasure so please encourage your child to enjoy a range of fiction and nonfiction texts at home.
