
Feel-Good Friday – P1-P7

- P1/2 Packets (suggested items; pasta, rice, soup, sauce)
- P2/3 Tins (suggested items; soup, beans, spaghetti, tuna, veg, tuna, custard, fruit)
- P3/4 Cereal (suggested items; cereal bars, porridge sachets)
- P5/6 Toiletries (suggested items; baby wipes, shower gel, shampoo, deodorant, soap, toilet rolls)
- P6 jars (suggested items; pasta sauce, add in sauce e.g. sweet & sour, mayo, beetroot, jam, ketchup)
- P7 Bottles/ drinks (suggested items; diluting juice, tea, coffee, hot chocolate)

Free School Meal and Clothing Grants

Free School Meal/Clothing Grant applications for 2024/25 are available here - : <u>Educational grants - South Ayrshire</u> <u>Council (south-ayrshire.gov.uk)</u>

The Scottish Government have committed to providing a free school meal to all P1 to P5 pupils, however we are requesting that parents/carers who meet the eligibility criteria submit an application as this information will be used to pay free school meal payments during school holiday periods.

Please note that Clothing Grant eligibility criteria is now in line with the Criteria for Free School Meals. Information can be found using the link above.

If you need help with your application, you can call 0300 123 0900 to speak to a customer service advisor.

Children in P6 and P7 are charged 35p for milk.

Please note that applications need to be completed each school year and do not automatically continue.

You must apply each year.

School Car Park

Please refrain from using the school and EYC car parks for dropping off and collecting children at the start and end of the school day.

School and EYC car parks are strictly for staff, blue badge holders and visitors.

Thank you for helping keep all children safe on their way to and from school.

Day to day communication with class teachers will take place through Learning Journals.
