



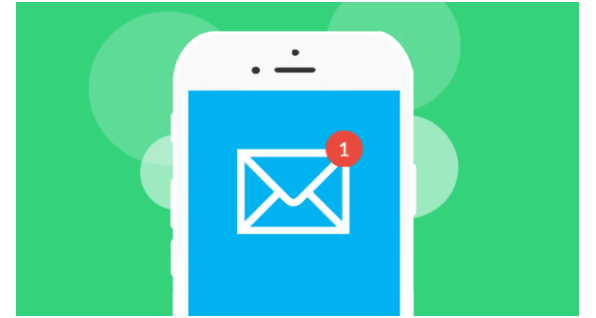

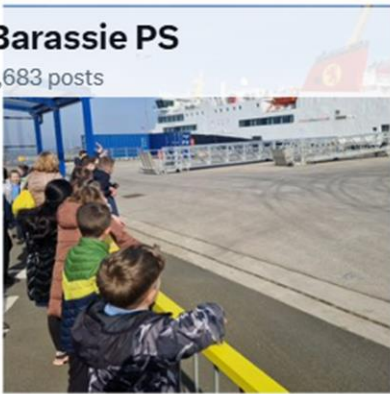

# Screens Awareness Week 2025

We are participating in Screens Awareness Week from Monday 5<sup>th</sup> May – Friday 9<sup>th</sup> May. All classes from P1-P7 have been learning about the pros and cons of screen time over the course of the past few weeks.

An information session for parents and carers has been arranged in partnership with colleagues from Speech and Language Therapy on **Friday 9<sup>th</sup> May at 2pm**. We would encourage you to attend this session to learn more about the impact of screen time on children's development, health and well-being.

## Screens Awareness Be screen smart

Spark a change for children, young people and their families



Screens awareness aims to raise the profile of the impact screen use has on child development, health and well-being.

### Excessive screen time:

can result in less time sleeping, poor sleep quality and excessive daytime sleepiness for children and young people

can lead to lower levels of fitness and greater risk of unhealthy weight in children aged 0-18 years

Is linked to low mood and low self esteem in children aged 0-18 years

can impact negatively on social skills and behaviour in children aged 0-7 years

can impact language development when used during the early stages of a child's life

Is associated with a smaller vocabulary in children aged 2 when parents or carers spend long periods of time watching TV or on other electronic devices

Screen awareness is an Ayrshire wide campaign led by Speech and Language Therapy, NHS Ayrshire & Arran's Public Health team in collaboration with the Health & Social Care Partnership's in East, North and South.

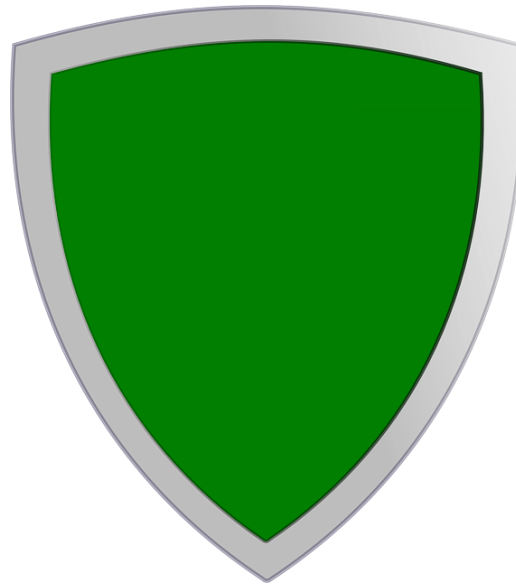

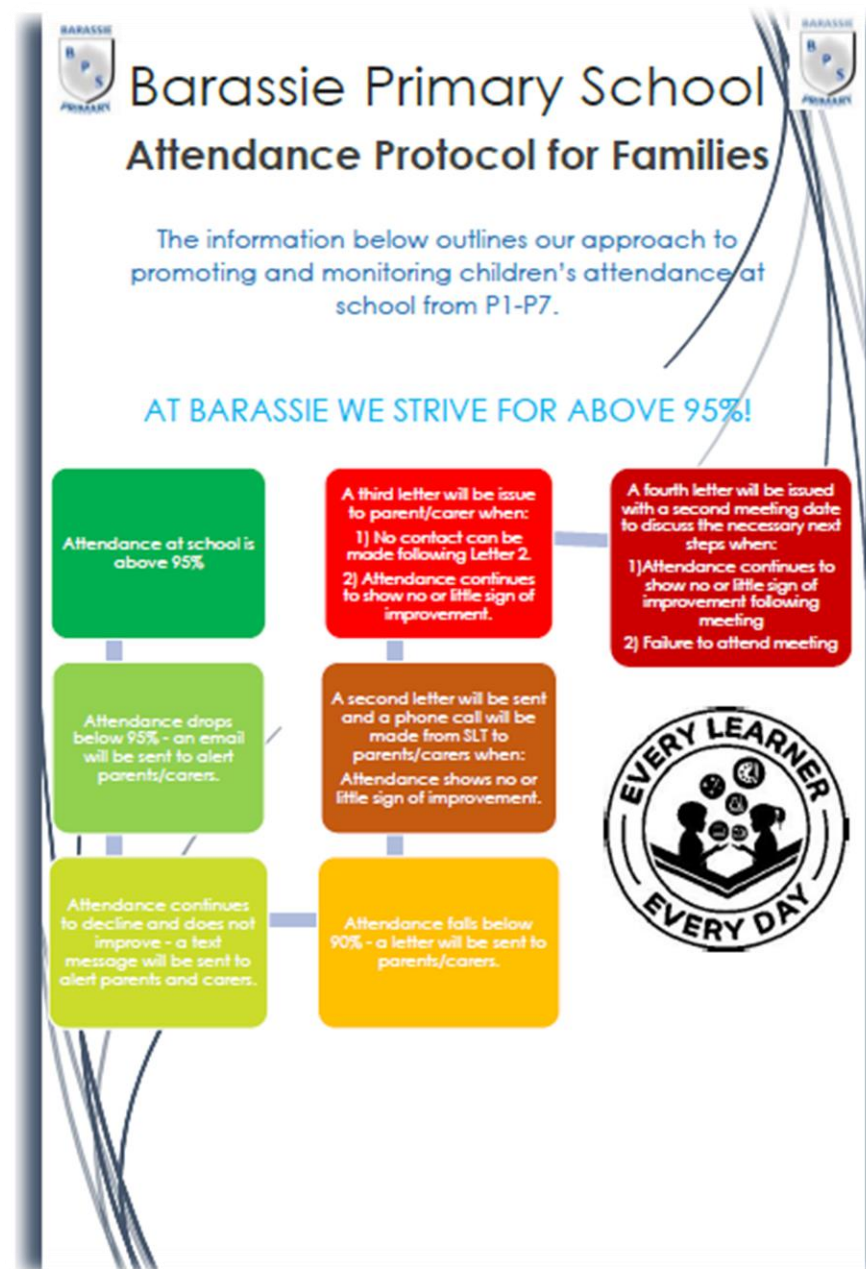

# Free School Meals



From 1<sup>st</sup> February 2025, the Scottish Government has added an additional qualifying criteria for access to free school meals. The change introduced is that families with pupils in P6 or P7 who are in receipt of the Scottish Child Payment can now apply.

# Free School Meal and Clothing Grants

Free School Meal/Clothing Grant applications for 2024/25 are available here - : [Educational grants - South Ayrshire Council \(south-ayrshire.gov.uk\)](https://www.south-ayrshire.gov.uk/educational-grants)

The Scottish Government have committed to providing a free school meal to all P1 to P5 pupils, however we are requesting that parents/carers who meet the eligibility criteria submit an application as this information will be used to pay free school meal payments during school holiday periods.

Please note that Clothing Grant eligibility criteria is now in line with the Criteria for Free School Meals. Information can be found using the link above.

If you need help with your application, you can call 0300 123 0900 to speak to a customer service advisor.

Children in P6 and P7 are charged 35p for milk.

Please note that applications need to be completed each school year and do not automatically continue.

**You must apply each year.**
