







Dear Parent/Carer,

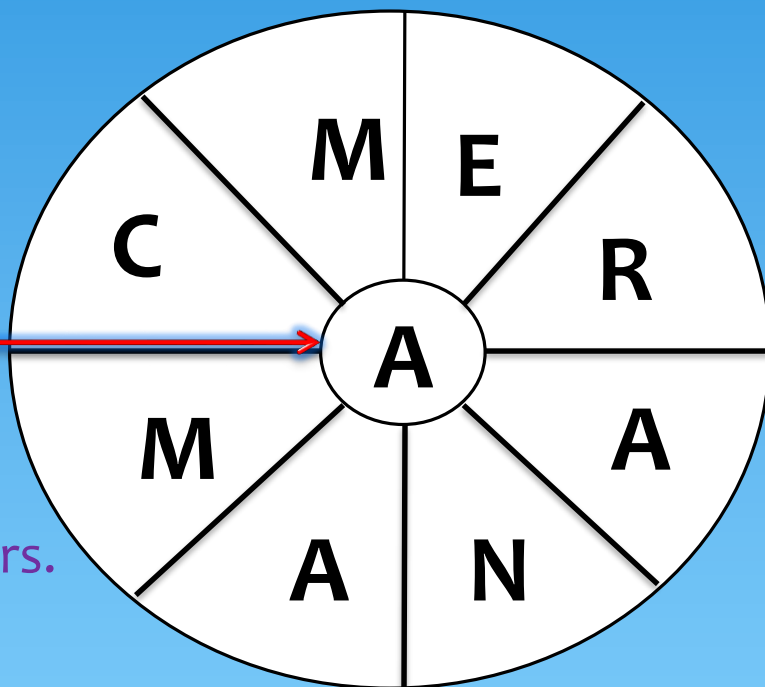

Share these with a parent/carer or feel free to send these on to me.</p> 	<p><b>S.T.E.M</b></p> <p><b>Technologies:</b> <b>Spaghetti shapes</b> Can you build a cube using 4 marshmallows and 12 half lengths of uncooked spaghetti? How wobbly is it? Can you make it stronger using more half lengths of spaghetti? Try making a pyramid with marshmallows and spaghetti. Then take them out, lay them on a tray, and check the brownness after three minutes, six minutes, and so on.</p>
