Incy wincy spider



Humpty Dumpty


Humpty Dumpty sat on a wall. Humpty Dumpty had a great fall.

- Hickory dickory dock Can you create a clock and a mouse puppet to act out the song, you could use a variety of materials or resources you have in the house including cereal boxes, old papers, old pieces of materials etc.
- Ba Ba black sheep Sing rhyme karaoke style

- Incy wincy spider Can you create a story about incy wincy spider, this could be carried out in a variety of ways. Either using paper and pens, or you could do a visual story using a variety of pictures which could be spoken about.
- Humpty dumpty create a Hard boil an egg and decorate it using felt pens or paint. Build a wall for your Humpty Dumpty

using blocks or Duplo.



- Twinkle twinkle little star Collect lots of shining things e.g. tinfoil, sequins, glitter, tinsel, a lit torch. Use some items to make a sparkly picture
- Other ideas for all rhymes would be to use wrong words or miss out words so that children have to correct you.
