Information for Passengers

The Bar: Opens at 8am and closes at 11.30pm

Smoke Room: Lights are extinguished at 12 midnight

Divine Service: In the saloon on Sunday at 10.30am

Wireless Telegrams: Passenger steamers of the White Star Line are fitted with the Marconi system of Wireless Telegraphy and messages for dispatch should be handed in at the enquiry office.

None of the ship's staff other than those on duty in the enquiry office are authorised to accept letters or telegrams for dispatch.

Baggage Questions: Refer to the Second Steward who is the ship's baggage master.

Steamer Rugs: Can be hired at a charge of £1 each for the voyage

Exchange of Money: The Purser is prepared, for the convenience of passengers, to exchange a limited amount of English and American money and he will allow a rate of \$4.80 to the £ when giving American money for English currency, or £1 for \$4.95 when giving English money for American money.
