What we are Learning at Nursery

This is a brief description of the learning we have planned for your child over the next two weeks at nursery. All learning is guided by the Curriculum for Excellence and planned according to the needs and interests of all the children in our setting. Culzean Room

- Our learning in maths and number will be all about money. We will be learning about how money is used in real life. Play opportunities will help children understand the purpose of money and how we can pay for things in different ways. We will be setting up a Christmas Post Office in the role play area where children can use money in imaginary situations.
- We will also be learning that print carries meaning, e.g. names and addresses on our mail. We will talk about the difference between letters and numbers and children will create their own parcels, letters and cards to post and deliver within the setting.
- As Christmas gets a little closer, children will learn about the Christmas story, and why it is our most celebrated Christian festival. Children will also have the opportunity to learn how to perform Christmas songs as part of the setting's Christmas celebrations.

Children in the Croy room will continue with their existing learning themes. We will let you know the new learning themes for this room week beginning 6th December.
