What we are Learning at Nursery

This is a brief description of the learning we have planned for your child over the next two weeks at nursery. All learning is guided by the Curriculum for Excellence and planned according to the needs and interests of all the children in our setting. Culzean Room

- We are kicking off 2022 by learning about the features of winter weather and investigating how freezing weather can turn rain and water into snow and ice. Children will take part in activities such as freezing/melting experiments indoors and outdoors & activities that help them understand why weather is important and how it is recorded.
- Alongside understanding cold weather, children will learn about animals that thrive in cold conditions such as the polar regions. We will also think about what we do to stay warm and cosy in winter.
- As we all return to the centre following our festive break, children will take part in lots of activities that help develop their skills in listening, taking turns and following simple instructions.

Croy Room

- We are exploring how to kick a large ball and walk up and down stairs one foot at a time to enhance our gross motor skills.
- We are learning about everyday technologies and how we us them in our world around us.
- We will be exploring different types of water play and discovering how the water can turn to ice.
