



Literacy

- I have set a Spelling challenge for you all on Sumdog. Most have you have been playing the Maths games – look out for Literacy challenges too. I am tracking how well you are all doing and will change these challenges weekly.
- We currently have an Accelerated Reading competition in school to see which class can read the most words. In the past two weeks we had 6 pupils in our class quiz on their books. Remember to use the link on the school website to quiz. Keep your eyes peeled on the website/ twitter for P4/5 to shooting to the top of the leader board!! To check any book levels of books you have at home please use www.arbookfind.co.uk (More info on school website). Follow instructions on school website to gain hundreds of books online through 'Libby, By Overdrive'.
- Continue reading your literature circle books and tasks if you have not finished yet (follow Grid 1 instructions for this task).
- Continue to use www.pobble365.com daily for a new picture stimulus for writing or answer the questions shown on the website.
- Create a comic strip about a relevant hero. There are so many 'key workers' right now who are heroes to us! Can you create a comic strip about what they are doing? You can draw your boxes for pictures and words if you are not able to print the template.
- Complete the Lewis Capaldi song lyrics inference questions – you will find them on the Additional Home Learning Grids page.
- Check Education City for a comprehension task which has been picked for you. There will be a new task given each Monday.
- On the Additional Home Learning Tab there is a P4-5 persuasive writing document to support you to write a persuasive argument about 'Whether outdoor or indoor play is best'. Pick your side! We have covered this in class. Remember your structure; an introduction, 3 detailed arguments and a conclusion. Think about what makes your argument stronger such as rhetorical questions and persuasive language. Please feel free to email me if you need more support with this task.
- Spelling revision – pick some active spelling strategies and revise your spelling words (you will find these in your homework jotter)
