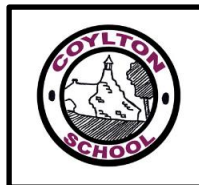

Literacy

- Sumdog Spelling: www.sumdog.com/user/sign_in. Play Sumdog regularly (logins are on front of your red jotter). Your next spelling pattern is ear and ea. Look at the task box on the left hand side and you will find your spelling challenge. Have fun!
- Writing: Talk 4 Writing "Sidney Spider A Tale of Friendship". Please refer to the sheet on the Additional Learning Grids. Work your way through the booklet and if you can't print it off, remember you can do the work in your jotter.
- Continue to keep in touch with your teachers! Remember, when you type an email, you are practising your writing skills!
- Handwriting: practise the ck and ch joins in your jotter. Continue to practise holding your pencil correctly and letter formations. Please refer to the sheet on the Additional Learning Grids entitled "Letter Formation".
- Grammar: see Education City www.educationcity.com for your activities on conjunctions. Use the login details you have on the front of your red jotter.
- Listening and Talking: watch Newsround www.bbc.co.uk/newsround.com and discuss with your family, especially if you have any concerns about anything.
