Reading

Continue to read a text of your choice every day. This should preferably be at your Accelerated Reading Level. Remember you can use the Epic App to find books at your level to then quiz on. We are continuing with our book study called Catscape!! This week aim to read **Chapter 4 and 5** and next week you try to read **Chapter 6 and 7**. Writing

Measure – Length

Complete the length activities found in the **P4/5 learning pack**. You have Reading Length and Measuring Length Converting Length tasks to complete. I suggest that for these activities P4 focus on the Bronze activities and P5 focus on the silver. There is a further Gold Challenge Converting Measurements. Remember to watch the videos before completing the tasks. If you wish to challenge yourself P4 then please do!! Length tasks will also be uploaded to Education City to complete. Practise measuring household items or even family members!

Weight

Complete the Weight activities found in the **P4/5 learning pack**. You have Reading Kilograms activity to complete. Again, Bronze is suited to P4 and Silver to P5. Weight tasks have also been uploaded to Education City. This is a perfect time to get the Kitchen scales out and have a go at measuring different amounts into them. Who knows you might be able to make something yummy! ☺

Volume

Complete the Volume activity found in the **P4/5 learning pack**. Again, Bronze is suited to P4 and Silver to P5. Remember to watch the videos before beginning the task. Volume tasks have also been uploaded to Education City.

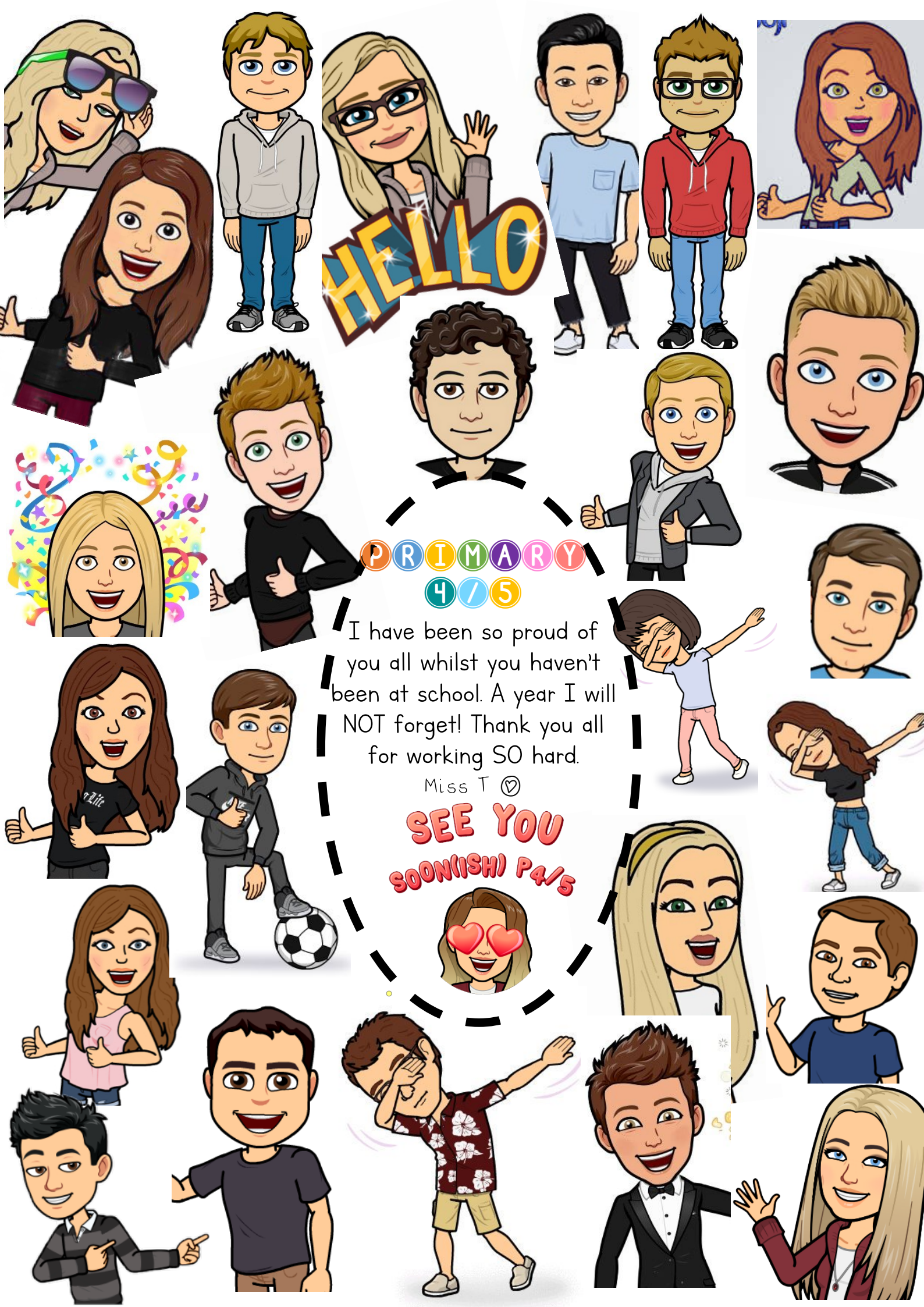
