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Dear Parents and Carers

Hi everyone! Can't believe it's the end of the week again. Thankfully, our school community is continuing to stay safe, and the number of children (and staff) who have had the cold seems to be decreasing too which is great! We are very much still in the middle of this pandemic as the First Minister outlined yesterday, with changes to restrictions coming into force in Scotland from Monday. In school, we are given briefings at least weekly on changes to guidance and we amend our risk assessment to fit the guidance when required. It is so important that as a school community, we continue to remain vigilant and work together!



Just a reminder to parents and carers – please return your child's flu immunisation forms if you intend your child to receive this. NHS are very much encouraging all families to take up this offer for children, particularly this year. NHS staff will not administer the immunisation without a completed form. **FORMS ARE BEING UPLIFTED NEXT WEEK!!!**

Can we also urge parents and carers to always let the school know if your child is going to be absent from school. You can call on 01292 612491, email in to Coylton.mail@south-ayrshire.gov.uk or send a text using Groupcall. This is particularly important if children are self-isolating as a result of their own COVID test, or because of a family member being tested. We also ask that you share with us the results of any COVID testing as the Scottish Government are carefully monitoring this data.



We have had a concern raised by a member of the community who lives close to the school. They are requesting that parents who park out on the street are considerate as some are parking over private driveways meaning residents are blocked in. We know that it is a difficult school for parking as the car park is not for parents to access either, but we ask that you give some thought to others when parking at drop off and pick up times.

We understand that some of our children are at home self-isolating due to COVID testing for family members – they are fit to be at school but can't be. We are working on a way to be able to still support learning at home for these children. Across Scotland, GLOW accounts are being reset, this could be why some are finding accessing Teams difficult. Until we can use this as an effective method of providing home learning, staff in classes will contact families at home with some information on the type of things being covered in class. We also have the home learning grids from the lockdown period still on the school website and these are full of activities that children could work on.
