Christmas

Here are our plans so far for Christmas in school. I will also add on our Countdown to Christmas overview for this year.

Parties – each class will have access to the main hall for a party this year. Children are welcome to come to school in party wear or non uniform on their day. We won't be able to have children go home to change or change clothes as we have in the past, and so please have children come to school dressed for the whole day. Pantomime – sadly, we will not be going together to The Gaiety this year. Instead, we are supporting 2 local companies. We have bought a production called Winter Show Toyland for all EYC -P3 pupils. This is a live, interactive show with the children accessing it via the interactive panels in their classrooms. We have also purchased a production of Aladdin – 3 Wishes, 2 Vaccines and a Genie from The Takeaway Theatre company for all children in P1-7, and again, children will access this through the interactive panels in their classrooms.

Movie afternoons – all classes will choose a Christmas movie to watch and children will be provided with movies snacks for the afternoon. Sssshhhh....we are also hoping that a special visitor might get in touch with the children at some point too!!!!

Christmas Jumper – instead of wearing a Christmas jumper for one day in December to support a charity, we have decided to make it Christmas Jumper December! Children are welcome to wear a Christmas jumper instead of their school sweatshirt from Wednesday 1st December until the end of term! Please note, this is not compulsory and some children may not want to – that is totally fine too! 😊

Christmas Lunch – Anna and the catering team are planning to have Christmas lunch. Letters are coming home about this today.

Christmas Crafts – obviously we won't be able to have our Christmas Bazaar but all classes are going to have an afternoon of Christmas craft, so look out for something wonderfully creative coming home.

Parent Council – activities are planned for children to take part in from Wednesday 1st December. These include Guessing the Polar Bear's birthday for P1-7, and Guess the Arctic Fox's birthday for the EYC, guess the sweets in the jar, and an amazing raffle.
