



The block of 10 swimming lessons for P5 pupils starts on Friday Ist September. Letters have already gone out to P5 parents, and so please ensure that all permission forms are complete and sent in as soon as possible. Pupils are permitted to wear sports clothes on swimming days as this allows for an easier change before returning to school. Friday swimming will count as one PE session for the 10 weeks.



Homework is part and parcel of school life here at Coylton Primary. We do understand that work commitments and busy family lives can be factors which can impact on homework tasks, and there is no obligation that tasks are completed, however if we can ask that as a minimum, all children have access to reading or having a story read to them daily at home - we absolutely see the positive impact of this in literacy activities back in school. PI pupils will receive log in details for Teams soon, but we will keep you posted. Homework tasks start on Monday ^{4th} September – please get in touch if you are struggling to get onto Teams. Remember, it will take a bit of time for our PI pupils to get Glow accounts set up, so we will be in touch with PI parents as soon as we can.



I am pleased to say that we are able to have school photographers in to take individual and family photographs. Dates have been confirmed as Monday ^{4th} September and Tuesday 5th September. All children from EYC to P7 will have photographs taken, and a sample will come home. There is no obligation to purchase any. Because family groups will be taken, we are unable to guarantee which of the 2 days your children will be photographed. We would ask that school uniform is worn. If your child normally has PE on these days, please don't send them in sportwear. Lessons will be planned to take this into account.
