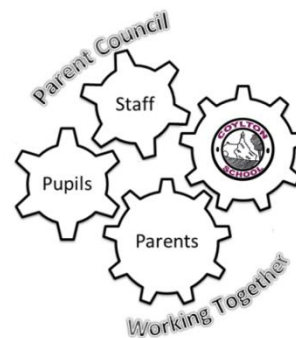

<p>2. Minutes of last meeting</p> <p>Mins from November meeting agreed and seconded</p>	
<p>3. Ayrshire Road Alliance</p> <p>Pavement widening starting soon(aim 6th February) take up to three months to complete. David Will forward plans to school and letter of notification . Notification letter to be circulated to parents. Monitor car parking once road widening complete. Previous consultation with public rejected need for drop off are, school no knowledge of consultation and would have stated one was needed Signage will be put out by contractor. Temporary walk way while works on going. Work will stop between school commuting times. SPT are notified and will make school bus companies aware. Lights manually controlled at peak times.</p> <p>Fiona Donnelly stated closing school gates has been very successful to stop school car parking issues. Noted some parents coming after 9am once gates are open again. They will keep this up.</p>	

<p>Kirsty Murdoch mentioned Pavement/Road are same material at Highpark area. David Manson mentioned this is a different budget. Needs looked at (community council).</p> <p>Ian Mair asked David about traffic enforcements and also asked about cycling. Donna explained that £15,000 had been awarded for shelters at school. Work started just after New Year and the are being placed next to the garage in younger playground.</p> <p>Mentioned about West Side of Coylton issues once finished. David has stated he can be emailed.</p> <p>Gavin Cockurn Councillor Connelly seemed positive with the plans. Both agreed that issues will arise at West Side too and have agreed to monitor this.</p> <p>Barbara Rae - Trail blazer scheme Scheme is to encourages active walking/cycling to school. It's a pilot scheme which Coylton primary has been picked to do. There will be five/ten minutes signs dotted about with QR codes with road safety messages. Children get certificates. Main aims are park and stride or hopefully walk to school. Starts after Easter. It will be independently evaluated. The scheme will run for six months to a year. Signs will stay up on the lights and will be child friendly and the horse is the symbol. She will send a map to council for us to approve and agree on main routes.</p> <p>Fiona stated Dawn/Lauren p4/5 teachers can tie in with Barbara. <p>5. Head Teacher's Update</p> <p>Decision to be made if school show is held this year or not P1 registration push. Transition for p7 currently happening which takes place face to face or over teams with Ayr Academy. Some children are away just now to Dolphin House on support transition event. Campus Police got funding from Police Scotland for martial arts for P7 Transition to Ayr Academy Burns supper- p7s choose to have an in school event Jacket pegs were mentioned and Fiona said p4-p7 coats are in classes. Inspection stated pegs were a fire risk so looking at getting more mobile coat racks. PE days keep changing due to active sports and Ayr United etc availability. Possible school uniform for PE??
