Ayr Academy Challenge Days

Pupils in P7 will join pupils from cluster schools at the first challenge day at Ayr Academy on Tuesday 10th October. A letter will come home with P7 pupils today with more information. Ayr Academy is our associated secondary school and so ALL P7 pupils should attend the challenge days in order to experience secondary school transition.

On Wednesday I5th November there is an opportunity for Parents/Carers and upper primary pupils to visit Ayr Academy after the school day to meet staff and see the facilities across the school. I would encourage as many families as possible to go along to Ayr Academy and have a look around, check out the fantastic facilities and chat to staff. It is

important that you visit before making a decision about secondary school for your child. Families with pupils from P5 – P7 are welcome to go along.

On Thursday 23rd November Ayr Academy are hosting a Welcome to Ayr family night for SI families, however parents/carers of upper primary pupils are also invited to attend the event. Details of times for this event will follow.

There will be a marketplace of supports that Ayr have on offer for pupils, and opportunities for family workshops including fun activities and family supports.



Staged Intervention

Staged Intervention is the assessment and planning framework used both in South Ayrshire and widely across Scotland to identify and plan interventions for children to ensure that they receive the earliest, most inclusive and least intrusive response to their needs. Staged Intervention is a way of ensuring children receive support at the right level to meet their needs.

The Inclusion Team, within Educational Services at South Ayrshire Council, have amended the Staged Intervention paperwork and guidelines for the Staged Intervention process. Paperwork will now be issued <u>twice each year</u>, rather than previously being three times each year.

The Staged Intervention model has also changed and is now as follows: -

- > <u>Stage I</u> Where additional supports are delivered through class-based strategies / interventions.
- > <u>Stage 2</u> Where a pupil will access support from the <u>Additional Support for Learning Teacher</u> Mrs Connor, Mon-Wed or Mrs Cox (Group Support Teacher) Wed, or School Assistants through Targeted Interventions outwith the classroom, e.g. Plus I, Power of 2, phonics, comprehension, decoding.
- > <u>Stage 3</u> When a child's needs cannot be fully met within the school and <u>ONE</u> service is involved, e.g. Speech and Language, School Nurse, Barnardo's, Occupational Therapy.
- > <u>Stage 4</u> Care Experienced / Looked After children, Social Work intervention OR direct regular support from MORE THAN ONE service.

Pupils who are currently requiring additional support for their learning will receive Block I Staged Intervention paperwork next week. Any child who is new to this process, then parents/carers should have received a telephone call from the class teacher.

This paperwork will run from September-January 2024. Please could we ask that parents and carers take time to read over the paperwork, and <u>sign and return one copy to school</u> so we can retain a copy in pupil files.
