# <u>Trailblazers</u>

Our school was selected to take part in the pilot of Trailblazers, an active school travel initiative. The pilot is funded by Transport Scotland and will be independently evaluated by Aecom in December. The initiative involves signs being placed along popular routes to s highlighting the time it takes to walk to school from that point. This will either be 5 or 10 minutes. If you live a significant distance from the school you can still drive to a safe location near a sign and walk, cycle or scoot from there. Along the route, parents/carers can scan the Trailblazer QR code on lamp post stickers which will take you to a daily message from the character Blaze, the pony.

The signs have been up on the lampposts since the beginning of the new term and for the next few weeks our newly formed JRSO Committee (Junior Road Safety Officers) from P5 and P6 will be encouraging more people to walk, cycle or scoot to and from school and the Early Years Centre. The JRSO's shared more information about Trailblazers at our assembly today.

From Monday 13<sup>th</sup> November until Friday 8<sup>th</sup> December, the JRSO's will be issuing prizes to pupils who are walking, scooting or cycling to school regularly each week. We are very aware that 10% of our pupils travel to school in a taxi/minibus and are therefore at an unfair advantage. Our JRSO Committee plan to feed this back to Aecom during the evaluation visit in December. But don't worry, we are planning a special Christmas activity which will allow ALL learners in the school to have the opportunity to win a Trailblazer prize!



This week, the children have been actively rehearsing for our upcoming nativity, and the progress is truly impressive. We are eagerly anticipating the opportunity to showcase their hard work and talents on Monday, December II<sup>th</sup>. At 2pm.
