We generally get things right, and are always available to talk to parents and pupils about classes. Restructuring every year really does helps support when children move on to secondary school as already, they have had experiences of mixing with others within their year group every year of primary school.



P6 and P7 School of Rock Showcase

Following the success of the musical showcase at Christmas, P6 and P7 pupils are very busy rehearsing for a new showcase based on the musical School of Rock! They are working closely with Mr Thomson who will direct the showcase, and also with their class teachers. We will have 2 performances, held in our own school on:

## Health and Wellbeing in P6 and P7 classes

Pupils across P6 classes will be working on some lessons within Health and Wellbeing related to Puberty over the next couple of weeks. P7 pupils learned about Conception to Birth this week, and I would like to praise them for the mature attitude shown. These topics are

very much part of Second Level experiences and outcomes within Curriculum for Excellence and will be handled sensitively through the use of cartoons and online characters. The Experiences and Outcomes are listed below:

## <u>Parentsportal</u>

#### What is Parentsportal?

The traditional school bag run has been used to facilitate communication between parents and schools for generations. Parentsportal provides a digital solution to this issue, making it easier for parents and carers to manage paperwork connected with school activities, and to obtain information about their child's educational progress at a time that suits them. The priority, as we introduce Parentsportal, is to enable parents to sign in and complete the Annual Data Check online. We will then be working on introducing additional services to the platform during 2024.

Our school is now live on Parentsportal, and links have been sent out via Groupcall Xpressions on how to sign up. This will make such a difference all round when it comes to the Annual Data Checks as we won't be sending home all the paperwork — it's good for the environment too as we won't be using reams of paper of the photocopier. Please don't hesitate to contact the school office for more information. So far, we have 70% of families signed up, so please take a few minutes to link in.
